We were suppose to move today but the wheather didn't permit. We were going to hump about 2 clicks SW and then set up a night logger. This is a pretty good area, we have ^{not} seen or heard any signs of gooks, I feel pretty safe.

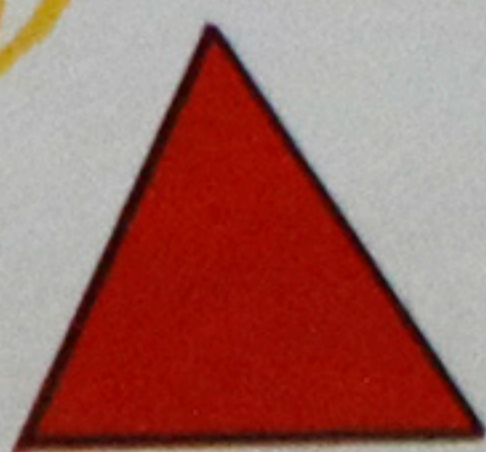
