If I stay here very long I will be able to write pretty regular again.

I am on flatlands for a change. There aren't any mountains around here. I went on a small patrol today. There is a lot of little villages all around us. The people have sweet corn, pineapple & bananas growing all around us. We are not suppose to eat any but we do.

I sent Nancy a roll of film today. There is a lot of pictures of Vietnamese people on it. I am running out of film. I only have one roll left.

If I stay this far south for a couple of months I might miss the monsoons. We are getting all our resupply directly off of Cam Ranh Bay now.

We had a company formation today and about 20 of us guys got awarded the C.I.B. Everybody gets one sooner or later, the only requirement is you have to be in the Infantry in a combat zone.

Well, I guess I had better end here. I have to go make sure everybody is filling sandbags.
